

**FORMULATIONS OF DENATURED ALCOHOL TREATED AS EXEMPT UNDER
ARTICLE 27(1)(b) of Directive 92/83/EC in THE NETHERLANDS**

	Formulation	Approved use
A	<p>At least one of the following denaturants per 100 litres of ethanol:</p> <p>50 ml oil of jasmine;</p> <p>250 ml of bergamot oil;</p> <p>125 ml bergamot oil (free of terpenes);</p> <p>180 ml perfume composition;</p> <p>180 ml oil of lavender;</p> <p>250 ml oil of eucalyptus;</p> <p>500 g methyl salicylate;</p> <p>250 ml oil of mint;</p> <p>40 g 4-acetyl-1,1-dimethyl-6-tert-butylindane;</p> <p>2.5 g denatonium benzoate (benzyl-diethyl(2,6-xylyl-carbamoylmethyl)ammonium benzoate)</p> <p>500 ml diethyl phthalate</p>	Manufacture of perfumes, toiletries, and cosmetics
B	<p><u>Per 100 litres of ethanol:</u></p> <p>5 litres of a mixture of liquids containing: 60%vol methanol, 11%vol of fusel oil (concentrate of products obtained by alcoholic fermentation), 20%vol acetone, 8%vol water, 0,5%vol butanone and 0,5%vol formaline (aqueous solution of 37% by weight of formaldehyde), and a colour solution complying with the concerning demands of the Dutch Customs Laboratory</p>	Household cleaning spirits
C	<p><u>Per 100 litres of ethanol:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - at least 1%vol light oil (petrol) or gasoil or 0,1%vol ETBE; or - denaturation of the ethanol should be in compliance with the concerning demands of the Dutch Customs Laboratory. Amongst others this paragraph includes isopropanol as a denaturant of ethanol when it is mixed in a quantity of at least 5%vol, i.e. 5 litres of isopropanol per hectolitre pure ethanol. 	Other products than under A and B
