For 1 kg of alcohol:

2:6	40 g n-Butyl alcohol
2:7	50 g Ethylacetate
2:8	100 g Isopropyl alcohol

Schedule 1:1 to 1:4 has to be used in the manufacturing of cosmetic products. Schedule 1:5 only in mouthcare products. Instead of pepparmint oil similar oils or mixtures can be used.

Schedule 2 denaturants are used for direct purposes like desinfection, cleaning, as a solvent or as a part of product containing alcohol. If the alcohol content of a product is more than 60-70 % there must be a mixture of at least 3 different denaturants in the product. With an alcohol content between 20-60 % there should be 2 different denaturants.

Decisions regarding denaturing are made by the Medical Products Agency.
